



What is networking?

Computer networking is simply a group of computers and devices (like printers and copiers) that are connected to each other for the purpose of communicating with each other. In addition to sharing hardware, users share files and software and other resources.

What will I learn in the networking class?

In addition to gaining a basic understanding of networking technologies, including mobile, cloud and virtualization technologies, you'll learn the skills required to:

- troubleshoot, configure, and manage common network wireless and wired devices.
- establish basic network design and connectivity.
- understand and maintain network documentation.
- identify network limitations and weaknesses.
- implement network security, standards, and protocols.

Can I take this class online?
